You will also be able to get free YHA membership for one year.

Time commitment

You can volunteer with YHA for your Bronze, Silver or Gold Award. We welcome applications from 3 months up to 18 months.

We ask that volunteers give a minimum of 1 hour per week for the duration of their time with us.

Help with expenses

√ Food

If you volunteer at a catered YHA, you can access meals at the reduced rate of £2 per meal.

√ Support

All volunteering placements will have a designated Line Manager to support you during your time with us.

* Accommodation

As you will be volunteering in your local area, we would not expect you to require accommodation to fulfil your time with us

* Travel costs

No travel expenses are available for this role.

Application process

We want to make sure that our placements are right for our volunteers, and that people will really benefit from spending time with us.

To make sure that we are a good fit, we carry out an application process.

Please apply using our online application form.

Your form will be processed, and we will contact your referees. We will then get in touch with you to arrange a short and informal telephone interview.

If you are applying to volunteer at a hostel, we will put you in touch with the Hostel Manager.

We aim to place as many volunteers as we can, however due to availability this is not always possible.
