- Resolving issues with the young people arising from behaviour or illness
- Providing lights out and night duty on a rota basis
- Escorting/driving young people to the doctors etc. if required
- Maintaining confidentiality of participant information

Time commitment

To help ensure continuity at camps, Senior volunteers ideally need to commit to all of the weeks their chosen camp is taking place.

You will be required to attend the training course at YHA Edale (Derbyshire). For Senior volunteers this commences on Thursday 14 July and will include briefings with the hostel and camp managers, first aid training and will continue with the Team Leader training until Sunday 17 July.

Skills, knowledge and experience The

Senior Volunteer role is suitable for people who have proven experience working or volunteering with young people in a responsible position.

Successful candidates will demonstrate experience of;

- Dealing with challenging behaviour in young people
- Coaching and mentoring others
- Organising and leading activities
- Effectively multi-tasking and prioritising competing demands
- providing leadership in stressful situations

Help with Expenses

We can offer expense reimbursement of up to £110 in total to help with travel costs to training and camp Accommodation and food is free of charge whilst you volunteer.

Recruitment process

The recruitment process involves an application form, selfdeclaration form and DBS check.

You will be required to provide the contact details of two people we can approach for references, one of these must be able to comment upon your experience of working or volunteering with young people.

You will then be invited to attend a group selection event followed by an interview with our friendly staff.
