Where can I do this?

Help is needed at YHA sites across England and Wales. The roles available are identified by the Hostel Manager based on the needs of the site. Help is needed in the week, at weekend and on Bank Holidays.

Help with expenses

Support ✓ All volunteers would receive an induction, training (applicable to their role) and ongoing support from a line manager.

Travel costs ✓ Volunteers can claim up to £15 per day to help with travel expenses.

Food ✓ When volunteering, volunteers are able to purchase meals from YHA at a discounted rate of £2 per course.
